Tips for Success

- Choose the warmest, free draining & most sheltered site you can find on your section.
- Prepare the planting hole by digging out existing soil to as deep as possible and approximately 60-70cm wide.
- Clay soils can be improved with Gypsum. Apply between 500gm-1 kg this will help break up clay so that roots can establish.
- Incorporate some quality planting mix.
- Position a stake, hammer in hard. Choose a soft tie so as not to damage tree bark.
- Plant the tree to the same depth that it comes in the planter bag. Position the tree in the prepared planting hole to gauge finished planting depth. It's important not to bury too deep which could result in the tree being too wet. Planting too shallow can leave feeder roots exposed to the air which may result in tree drying out and being vulnerable to wind rock.
- Water tree well and inspect regularly.

- Fruiting may take between 2-3 years, but trees live a long time so they're well worth the wait.

Apples

Key to Apple Graft Heights:

M9: Dwarf tree height 3m. Suits well drained, fertile soils. Not suitable for heavy clay soils. Requires tree support due to shallow root system.

M26 & M27: Dwarf best in good, free draining soil can be grown without tree support in sheltered areas. 3.5-4m.

M102: Semi Dwarf 4-5m.

MM106: Semi Dwarf - height 4.5m. Good on most soils, does prefer free drainage but probably the best suited to difficult sites.

MM116: Semi Dwarf-height 4.5m. Better suited to difficult soils (heavy or clay) than other root stocks.

Pollination - Apples are normally self-fertile, or at least partially, but fruit set can be improved through cross-pollination with other apple varieties planted nearby. Trees on neighbouring properties will also assist pollination. Some of the best all-round pollinators are 'Braeburn', 'Gala', 'Golden Delicious', 'Liberty', 'Peasgood Nonsuch' and 'Splendour'. Crab apples are also noted as being good pollinators for eating varieties.
